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On Thursday, February 15th from 5.00pm to 9.00pm in SOFIA, the capital of Bulgaria, the personal exhibition of the Trentino artist PAOLO VIVIAN, entitled "MARE NOSTRUM", will be inaugurated at the prestigious HOSTGALLERY. Known for his research in the field of collective memory, identity and their impact on social behavior, this time the artist focuses his interest on the theme of migration and

humanitarian socio-cultural problems. "Mare Nostrum" by Vivian, proposes an elegiac symbolic work, dedicated to hope, investigating the concept of the border, through video, sound and photography. Until March 15th in the spaces of the HOST GALLERY in Sofia, a multimedia installation of two large-scale video projections, ambient sounds and a large photographic installation surrounding it will be on display. Through these three components of the holistic exhibition, Vivian invites the public from the entrance to the gallery "dressed" in blue, to immerse themselves in a hypnotic and mysterious world in search of the secrets of existence and hope. During the show it will be organized the giuded visits and an artist talk. Mare Nostrum by Paolo Vivian at HOSTGALLERY is curated by Dora Bulart and it runs until 15 march 2024.



artist's words

"Mare Nostrum" is a video with a metaphorical impression. My work was inspired by issues related to migration and refugees, it focused on the theme of both internal and external borders. It is a sensation expressed through a few continuously moving images as a metaphor of geographical borders, religious divisions, cultural diversities, internal borderlines, and the most extreme border for many people on the run, death. The other aspect of the work is linked to the internal journey in search of hope, where sometimes we are the refugees, fleeing from ourselves, outlining our borders. The sea is a symbol of hope, passion and transformation." Paolo Vivian

words of the curator

Vivian's project "Mare Nostrum" is very engaging, in fact, it is like a silent conversation of future memories and the boundaries within us. The artist used an everyday object and created an unreal world of hypnotic beauty and spiritual metamorphoses. With abstract images, with the transmutations of shots and shapes, with overflow of colors - those of the spirit and those of passion, Vivian draws a thin border line between life and death, between dream and myth, between Earth and Sky. The video emerging from space, the

meditative ambient sounds, the memory cubes in the photographic installation, all of them, are the artist's tools to provoke his audience in the search for the secrets of the essence of the internal cosmos and awakening. It is a work with an elegiac character, where if you are attentive you could discover the outline of hope. The hope of a more beautiful, more loving world."

"Inspired by the attention on the major theme of our times, that of migrants and their tragic lives, we have decided to open the 2024 season of the HOST GALLERY with a provocative exhibition by the well-known Italian artist Paolo Vivian. His project is site specific and, in fact, he transformed the gallery space into a sea, creating a poetic and hypnotic reality, where the color blue dominates. The exhibition generates strong emotions and I believe the public will be very enthusiastic. Furthermore, Vivian is already well known in Bulgaria, through his historic collaboration with the Bulart gallery.
